Background

World Health Partners (WHP) is a non-profit organization mandated to deliver holistic healthcare to underserved communities by innovatively leveraging available resources more efficiently. Evidence-based management and technological solutions that are sophisticated to work in extremely low-resource settings are the hallmarks of WHP's programming strategy. WHP believes that it is unconscionable to divide resources on an ideological basis—such as public and private sectors—since low resource settings focus on collectivizing all existing resources to achieve betteroutcomes.

WHP is best known for its programs focused on early detection and treatment of tuberculosis in urban and rural settings supported by community-based activities to ensure prevention. WHP currently operates its projects in Bihar, Jharkhand, Uttar Pradesh, Punjab, Haryana, Uttarakhand, Himachal Pradesh, Gujarat and Delhi.

About the project

The Government of Delhi has selected WHP to implement the **Patient-Provider Support Agency(PPSA) project** in seven revenue districts of Delhi (South, South East, New Delhi, West, South West, North, and North West).

This project is designed to directly support the efforts of the Government of Delhi and the Government of India for an effective and efficient TB program in the Private Sector. World HealthPartners (WHP) will contribute to TB control efforts through an intervention that will leverage partnerships and implementation experience in five key domains: 1) facilitate early and accurate diagnosis, 2) facilitate case notification, 3) ensure appropriate treatment, 4) ensure treatment completion and 5) ensure TB Prevent Therapy (TPT) to the eligible households. Multi-level technical capacity-building support is integrated with quality improvement and will be reinforcedthrough an ICT platform.

Scope of work and key responsibilities

Key Responsibility Areas (KRA) would include but not be restricted to the following:

- Provide health education and counseling to the patients and family membersregistered with the project
- Follow up with patients (home visit) to track treatment adherence.

- Record treatment adherence on regular basis/as mandated and treatment outcomeat the end of treatment
- Coordinate with all concerned to ensure that all contacts of sputum-positive patients are screened for TB
- Eligible contacts to be offered TB Preventive Treatment (TPT) as per NTEP guidelinein coordination with the private provider and NTEP staff
- Actively engages with patients who have left the treatment mid-way to resuming the treatment
- Provides information to patient/family member on social support/security schemes for which patient is eligible
- Collect A/C details of patients for DBT/bank seeding, and NPY benefits.
- Facilitate opening of bank A/C of notified patients (if they don't have any).
- The Treatment Coordinator will ensure to report every follow-up, treatment outcome, Contact tracing, etc. on Nikshay and simultaneously will share to MIS
- Collecting samples and report delivery during Contact Tracing
- To coordinate with Field Officers for validation of any patient details (if required).
- Patient verification & verification of free services received
- Ensure Universal Drug Susceptibility test (UDST) by sample collection and transportation
- Ensure Public Heath Action (PHA) such as comorbidity testing (HIV and DM)
- Perform other relevant duties aligned with the project objectives as required by WHP

Qualifications, Skills, and Competencies

- Essential: Bachelor's degree; Desirable: Social work/ Social Sciences/ Sociology/ Psychology from a recognized institution
- Experience: preferably 2-3 years in the relevant field. Work experience in TB programs, GFTAM projects or Public and Private Partnerships / Health projects /programs would be preferred
- Educated housewives, retired but active personnel, fresher's who keen to work for social cause also will be considered for the position
- Excellent Verbal and written communication skills in Local language and basic knowledge of English (written) is required
- Excellent counselling and Interpersonal skills
- Ability to travel extensively within the project area
- Must have a two-wheeler and a valid driving license
- Carrying a smartphone is compulsory for this position as all the reporting will be done through the mobile application
