Introduction

The Integrated Pediatric TB and Technology-Enabled Active Case Finding (ACF) Project, funded by The Global Fund is being implemented by SAATHII as Principal Recipient (PR) under the guidance of the Central TB Division (CTD) and SR partners under the guidance of the State TB Office of Punjab and Haryana. The key purpose of the project is to provide technical assistance to the National TB Elimination Program (NTEP) in these states to increase the access and availability of pediatric TB services across all levels of the health system in both public and private health sectors, and identify new TB cases among key vulnerable populations in selected districts using an AI technology enabled Handheld X-ray device.

World Health Partners (WHP) is a non-governmental organization that sets up programs to bring sustainable healthcare within easy access to underserved and vulnerable communities. It innovatively harnesses already available resources more efficiently by using evidence-based management and technological solutions. WHP is best known for its programs focused on Tuberculosis, primary healthcare, family planning, MNCH, and mental health. The organization uses all available resources-- both in the public and private sectors, to ensure that people living in any part of the project area will have access to high-quality treatment.

To support the above-mentioned project, we are inviting quotations from qualified Radiologists to interpret the X-ray films for KVPs of the following districts of Punjab and Haryana:

1. Objective of RFQ:

The primary objective of this RFQ is to invite proposals from bidders who can interpret the X-ray films for the Key Vulnerable Population (KVPs). The aim is to engage with Radiologists to support the early identification of TB among the KVPs.

2. Scope of CXR services provided by empanelment of one or more Radiologists:

- The project is collaborating with private Radiologists to interpret the Chest X-ray films to identify TB and other diseases that the project serves.
- The report should be given as per the standard CXR report format. Radiological findings and impressions/conclusions should be specifically mentioned in the report issued as per standard formats suitable for TB detection.
 - CXR radiological reports issued by qualified radiologists registered with the Medical Council of India (MCI) or equivalent authority. Radiological findings and impressions/conclusions should be specifically mentioned in the report issued as per the standard formats prescribed for TB detection.
 - Conclusions should mention CXR findings suggestive of TB or not suggestive of TB
- The radiologist shall share the signed reports with the project team (by email/WhatsApp to the team) within 48 hours of receiving the X-ray films.
- Data management, reporting, and confidentiality shall be adhered to by the bidder as per government norms.

3. Documentation:

- Project will send the X-ray films (Digital or hard copy) to the empanelled Radiologists through WhatsApp/email.
- After completion of each month, the empanelled Radiologists must ensure to submit an invoice including tax, having details for the number of CXR interpretations provided during the month.
- This invoice should be sent to World Health Partners by the first week of next month. The invoice must be supported by.
 - Line list of beneficiaries – CXR interpreted
 - CXR report of each patient (Soft copy).

4. Eligibility Criteria:

- **Qualified radiologists** registered with the Medical Council of India (MCI) or equivalent authority.

5. Submission requirement:

Interested bidders are requested to submit the following

- Technical Proposal:
 - Working hours
 - Highest Qualification and Registration Certificate
 - Financial Proposal
 - Per interpretation cost, including all and report
- ** Performa attached in Annexure I to submit the documents**

6. Duration of Contract:

- The contract is valid for an initial period of 6 months, which could be extended based on the project requirements.
- The notice period to stop the services is 15 days.
- The above-mentioned documentation mechanisms are to be ensured.

7. Terms and Conditions:

- Payment will be made as per the agreed rate contract on the submission of the agreed invoice documents.
- The MoU/contract will be terminated based on mutual agreement for the delay in service, quality of service, non-compliance with registration/certification, or delay in payments.
- WHP reserves the right to invite fresh bids with or without amendment of the RFQ at any stage or to terminate at any time the entire bidding/selection process without any liability or any obligation to any of the Bidders and without assigning any reason whatsoever.
- A Bidder shall not have a conflict of interest that affects the bidding process. Any Bidder found to have a Conflict of Interest shall be disqualified.
- All Bidders are required to submit their Bid in accordance with the terms outlined in this RFQ.
- Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in this RFQ, the detailed terms specified in the agreement shall have an overriding effect.
- Responses to quotes must be received no later than the date and time indicated on the RFQ.

8. Deadline for submission:

- All quotations should be submitted by the last date of receiving a quote is **March 5, 2026**.
